REACH Declaration

- EC 1907/2006 - Update to Candidate List of December 2018 -

The European Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force in June 2008.

In December 2018 new substances were added to the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) (<https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>)

DAVE doesn't produce or import substances or preparations which are concerned by the registration or pre-registration process according to REACH.

DAVE is a so called downstream user and made an inquiry along the supply chain to ensure that concerned substances or preparations will be recorded by the suppliers, and if not that there will be substitutes to qualify in due time for our products. So far the results based on our review and the available information and MSDS for each raw material we can confirm that our products don't contain substances listed in the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) with a concentration above 0.1% (w/w).

DAVE tracks the changes of the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) and checks the absence of the new added substances (<https://www.echa.europa.eu/substances-restricted-under-reach>)

From 01 December 2011, EU and EEA producers or importers of articles have to notify ECHA (European Chemical Agency) when their product contains a substance on the Candidate List. This obligation applies if the substance is present above 0.1% (w/w) and its quantities in the produced/imported products are above 1 tonne in total per year per company.


We confirm that we will notify you as our customer about any notification given to ECHA with regard to the products supplied to you.
